Club Closure for Christmas/New Year break - The Club is officially closed from Thursday 7th December., except for the Christmas Shop and associated access. Workshop sessions will begin again from Monday 15th January. *PLEASE NOTE*: No sessions or work is to be conducted at the Club during closure, including whilst the Christmas Shop is operating, except for planned cleaning and maintenance.

Christmas function - Our annual Christmas function this year was held at the Whalebone Hotel in Wonthaggi and 56 Woodies, partners and friends attended. The Club's Annual Award presentations were made, the raffle was drawn and Neil Lenne was presented with his Life Membership.

Christmas Shop - The Christmas Shop is nearly done and dusted for this year, and it's been very successful having it at our workshops. With a broad range of advertising including in the Sentinel Times, South Coast FM, shop windows, letterbox drop, other local community groups and a largely increased presence on Facebook and Instagram, the numbers coming through have been great. Thank you to the people who have supported all this advertising and publicity and thank you to the 23 members who contributed 800+ items for sale in the Shop—and this doesn't include the toys! In the first 10 days, we took \$12,000 from 350 sold items and hopefully that will extend before closure in 4 days time. A reminder to members to pick up their unsold items between 2pm and 3.30pm on Saturday, or arrange for someone else to do so. Please don't disrupt sales time by coming in to pack up prior to that. Any items not picked up will be stored in the meeting room and can be collected at the working bee on 12th January or earlier by personal arrangement with a key holder.

Woodies Annual Awards - Our Awards were again presented after a hiatus due to Covid restrictions for a couple of years. Congratulations to Award recipients and a big thank you to Neil Lenne, Steve Edge, Hartley Tobin and John DiStefano who created the beautiful perpetual trophies to go along with framed certificates and \$50 vouchers compliments of Bunnings Wonthaggi.

Bunnings Sausage Sizzles - A big thank you to Peter and Alex Myers for the organisation and running of our Bunnings events throughout the year. It's a substantial amount of work, but their dedication and efficiency have meant that the Club has earned over \$5000 for the year from these events. They have generally been well supported and the funds have substantially improved the Club's financial status as we look to add a new workshop during 2024. Recent Sausage Sizzles have each cleared around \$1100, so

everyone can see what important fundraisers these events are. They provide essential income to keep Woodies fees down. A special thanks also to Lex who once again efficiently managed all aspects of the raffle with Neil's support. It's no easy task and is another invaluable financial addition for our Club. Working bee - A working bee will be conducted on Friday January 12th. The tasks will be cleaning and maintenance of all adjacent outside areas including grass cutting and tree trimming. Cleaning of the kitchen, meeting room including tables, floor and carpet. Full clean of workshops including machines, floors, dust extractors, vacuum cleaners and overhead areas. 








Neil Lenne was very happy and proud to receive his well deserved Life Membership certificate and badge from Vice-President Lex Van Saane.
