Membership Fees 2023 - 2024

The Annual fees for existing members will be

1. \$115 (early bird rate) for Full membership (able to use club room equipment) if paid on or before 15 July 2023 (the AGM). If paid after 15 July 2023 and before 31 August 2023 the Full Membership fee is \$135
2. \$70 (early bird rate) for social membership if paid on or before 15 July 2023 (the AGM). If paid after 16 July 2022 and before 31 August 2022 the Social Membership fee is \$80.
3. \$60 (early bird rate) for Junior membership if paid on or before 15 July 2023 (the AGM). If paid after 16 July 2022 and before 31 August 2022 the Junior Membership fee is \$70.

If a member hasn't renewed their membership by 31 August they are no longer considered to be a financial member of the Club and will cease getting the benefits of the club, including use of the equipment.

CONTINUING CASH (OR CREDIT) REBATE - To encourage participation at a Fundraising BBQ, Club clean-up day or other club activity where members are required to assist a \$10 refund (in cash) will be paid for each occasion. If you attended the last January BBQ and/or 10 June 2023 BBQ you may have some membership rebates. I will work them out and let you know what you owe for 2023/24 membership.

New members will pay: Full \$140, Social \$85 and Junior \$75. 50% discount applies if joining on or after 1 January 2024.

Projects



Gordon Watt has made the lidded box from Camphor Laurel. The bowl is Mulberry and Kauri. Gordon is perfecting the art of adding a feature disc in the bottom. ;-)
The finish is Ubeaut Aussie Oil.



Beryl Watling has used the left over pencil points from 2 previous projects to make this bowl. Blackwood forms the base.



Mario Fenech Has made the vase (on the left) and the bowl from OGK and the finish is Shellawax.



Peter Lucas has been very busy with his Bolt Action pens and Bullet pens.



A closer look at his pens. Particular attention is drawn to the Hairy Oak pen 4th from the right. The finish is Aussie Oil.



Lionel Hart has made the laminated bowl using Blackwood and Oregon (from a piano). The salt and pepper shakers have been made from Oregon. The finish is Nitro Lacquer but in the case of the Shakers the Nitro has had some stain added.



Lionel has also made these candle holders from Blackwood. Again, Nitro is the finish.



Cath Clifford has made this winged bowl from Banksia. The finish is Walrus Oil.



Kath has made the mushroom using Mulberry and finished with Walrus Oil. The hollow form is Ash and is finished in a similar manner.



Peter Fisher has used Ash to make the bowl, lidded box and vase. The finish is Bees Wax.
